Medicine: required for all of us. Our mothers, fathers, sisters, daughters. It is single handedly the most crucial part of the human race. Whether saving lives, curing a cough, easing our mind, or making us hale. It is undeniable the effects it has on all eight billion people. Why has medicine been immeasurably more successful in the last fifty years than any other time in human history? Artificial intelligence.

A.I has bolstered the path in the way we see and conduct modern medicine. It has granted physicians unprecedented tools to solve cases of dismay. A.I never needs to sleep, it is able to successfully detect and diagnose at a rate human beings cannot.
